Jessica has worked in the field of international recognition for 20 years and has 12 years of experience in the design and provision of training courses in credential evaluation and international recognition. Jessica has shared her knowledge of credential evaluation with hundreds of colleagues throughout her career at Nuffic. She has written and contributed to several publications, including chapters on the educational systems and evaluation of credentials in the USA and Australia for Nuffic's 'Handbook on the Evaluation of Foreign Educational Credentials'. She has also designed and written an on-line course on credential evaluation.
