The European Association for International Education (EAIE) is pleased to announce the launch of its Professional Development Modules. These modules will give EAIE members an opportunity for professional development at an academic level. The EAIE will offer one-week modules in association with various European universities. Topics will cover issues related to the internationalisation of higher education and higher education management. Upon successful completion of the module ECTS credits will be awarded. These credits will be recognised for related degree programmes at the university offering the module.

Upcoming modules

The first EAIE Professional Development Module will take place 21–25 July 2008 in partnership with the International Centre for Higher Education Research (INCHER) at the University of Kassel, Germany. The registration deadline for this module entitled 'Strategies of internationalisation in higher education: A research-based analysis of developments and practice' is 26 May 2008. Another week-long module, 'Quality management in higher education', will be organised in association with the Center for Higher Education Policy Studies (CHEPS), Enschede, The Netherlands and will take place 13–17 October 2008. The registration deadline is 18 August 2008.

Admission requirements

These modules will be offered exclusively to EAIE members. You can become a member when registering for a professional development module. Participants must hold a BA degree and should have practical working experience of at least one year in the field. A good working knowledge of English, the language of instruction, is required.
