Training Courses

This year's training course programme is an exciting mix of old favourites and new additions. By popular demand, eight courses from last year will again be offered covering topics such as credential evaluation, international recruitment, student advising, and management.

In addition, ten new courses have been added to the list designed to give education professionals at all stages of their international career the opportunity to gain valuable skills in their field. Course subjects vary from learning how to create sustainable business relations for internship placements to developing intercultural communication skills, and marketing an institution. All training courses last between two and four days and take place in a variety of cities throughout Europe.
