### **New EAIE Occasional Paper – ‘Internationalisation at Home: ideas and ideals’**

In the latest addition to the EAIE’s *Occasional Paper* series, editor Hanneke Teekens, in partnership with eight other authors, explores the theme ‘Internationalisation at Home’ (IaH). Released at the 19th Annual EAIE Conference in Trondheim, Norway, this volume draws on both ‘old’ and ‘new’ input, bringing together theory and practice on IaH. Alongside introductory and theoretical chapters, various initiatives taking place in different institutions in Mexico, Australia, China, Canada, South Africa, Sweden and the USA are presented as case studies, covering specific aspects of IaH such as institutional policy, diversity on campus, language, and engagement with the local community.

The theme ‘Internationalisation at Home’ (IaH) is a topic that continues to be of great interest to many EAIE members, and enjoys a lot of attention at the EAIE’s conferences and training courses. The editor hopes that this *Occasional Paper* will give readers “some good ideas, inspiration and ambition for change” as they seek to secure and improve access, for all students, to an international and/or intercultural experience in higher education.

This publication is complementary to the volume ‘Implementing Internationalisation at Home’ (edited by Jos Beelen) in the *EAIE Professional Development Series for International Education* that was published in parallel with this *EAIE Occasional Paper*.
