19th Annual EAIE Conference will be held in Trondheim, Norway

The 19th Annual EAIE Conference will be held from 12 to 15 September 2007 in Trondheim, Norway. Over 2100 international education professionals will travel from across Europe and the globe to attend.

The conference has grown substantially in popularity and reputation since its beginnings in Amsterdam, 1989. It now comprises an extensive training course programme, numerous networking opportunities, special events and the ever-popular exhibition. The Conference Programme Committee will have the difficult task of selecting approximately 85 conference sessions and training workshops from the 215 submitted proposals.

Conference host

The Norwegian University of Science and Technology (NTNU) will host the conference. The NTNU actively promotes mobility among its 21 000 students and researchers, and offers 23 Master programmes taught in English of which two are in the ERASMUS Mundus programmes.

Conference venue

The conference will be held in the Trondheim Spektrum congress centre. Bright, spacious and easily accessible, Trondheim Spektrum is only a 15-minute walk from the city centre and 10 minutes from the nearest airport bus stop. As the largest conference facility in Norway it attracts numerous international conferences every year.

Trondheim

Situated where the river Nid flows into the Trondheim fjord, Trondheim is in the far north of Europe – only 500 km from the polar circle. The warm Gulf Stream, however, ensures a fairly mild climate. Founded in 997 BC by Viking King Olav Tryggvason, the city occupies a special place in Norwegian culture and history. It was the first capital of Norway and continues to be the coronation city for Norwegian kings. Trondheim is an ecclesiastical center, a regional capital, and an important city for industry, commerce, education and research.
