While illustrations are drawn from specific jurisdictions, as law without context is meaningless, this *Occasional Paper* explores some of the issues that are topical across jurisdictions and addresses the more transferable elements of dispute avoidance, disputes and dispute resolution, including risk assessment, legal liability, the role of the ombudsman, prevention, mediation and insurance management.
