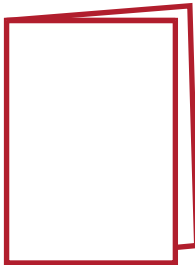
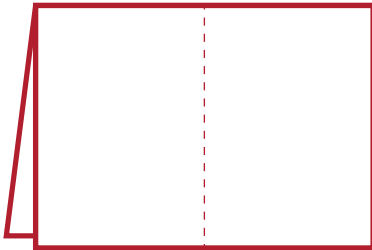
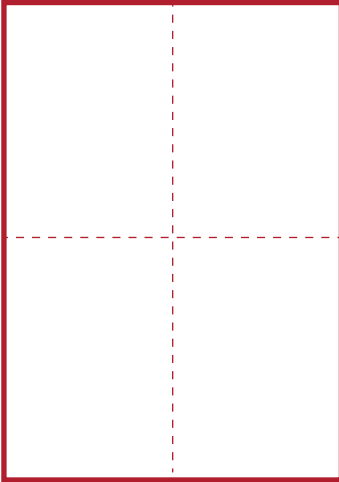


University of Macedonia (Greece)
