### Welcome reception I

1 This event is kindly hosted by the Bordeaux City Council and is free for all participants (no registration is required).

#### How to get there

**By tram:** From the main entrance of the university, cross the Victoire square and go the Victoire tram station. Take tram line B, in the direction of 'Berges de la Garonne' or 'Cité du Vin', and get off at the 'Hôtel de Ville' station (two stops). Cross the Pey Berland square. The Bordeaux City Hall is located behind the Saint-André Cathedral. Please go to the main entrance, next to 'Le Café Rohan'. The journey takes around 10 minutes.

**On foot:** From the main entrance of the university, cross the Victoire square, walk along the 'Cours Pasteur' street on the right, and simply follow the tram route until you reach the 'Hôtel de Ville' tram station. Cross the Pey Berland square. The Bordeaux City Hall is located behind the Saint-André Cathedral. Please go to the main entrance, next to 'Le Café Rohan'. **The journey takes around 20 minutes.**
