

02 – University of Toulouse Jean Jaurès- Campus Mirail: From facilities to community: a creative and lively campus to discover



Participants who would like to go to the Campus Experience by public transport may take the Metro line A (red line) from Station Mirail University to city centre Capitole. Upon arrival, student ambassadors will warmly welcome participants and guide them to the Board Room, where they will be received by the President and the International Office team. The journey will take participants through the heart of the campus Mirail, showcasing the main facilities and offering a glimpse into its various services: arts and music classrooms, libraries and student-led associations. Participants will also discover the array of on-campus and off-campus sports options. Finally, a highlight of the morning visit will be the unique university cultural centre "La Fabrique," where participants will attend a short performance.

Enjoy a cooking demonstration and tasting before engaging with staff and international students from the faculties, schools and institutes of the university's different campuses. The afternoon will be dedicated to discussing collaboration opportunities and exchanging best practices in internationalisation among students and staff.

About the institution

The University of Toulouse–Jean Jaurès specialises in the arts and humanities, languages, literature and social sciences. Established in the late 1960s and completely reconstructed from 2013 to 2023, it stands as a dynamic French public campus, inspiring societal engagement. Additionally, it offers technical undergraduate training through its two institutes of technology. The university is also dedicated to preparing future primary and secondary school teachers. Its campuses are situated not only in Toulouse but also in 10 other cities in the Occitanie region. Furthermore, the university has an offshore campus in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. With a vibrant student and cultural life, it has a total student enrolment of 31,000 and promotes values such as openness, creativity, inclusiveness, engagement and benevolence.
