### 05 – University of Glasgow: 575 years of global impact

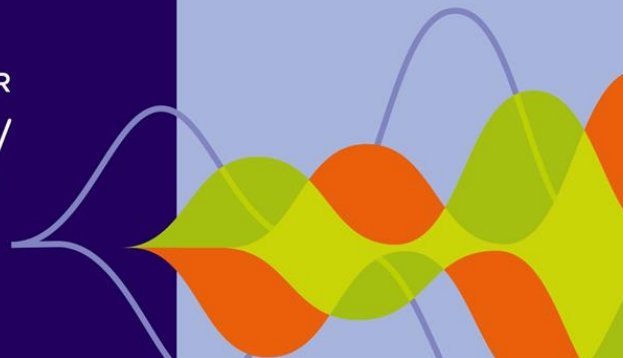
