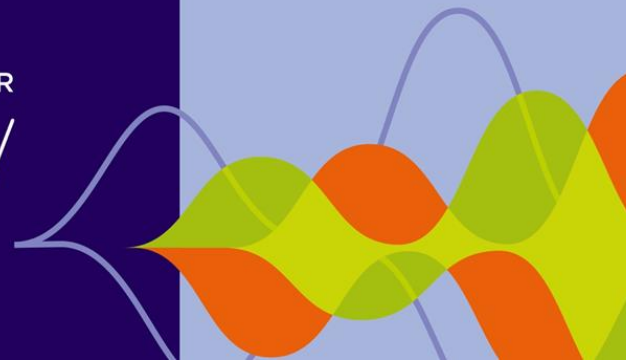


07 – University of Stirling: An international, pioneering university in the heart of Scotland

The University of Stirling Campus Experience will bring you to the historic City of Stirling, at the Gateway to the Scottish Highlands. You will be welcomed by the Senior Deputy Principal (International), followed by a presentation giving an overview of the university's rich history, strategic aims and global partnership initiatives. About the institutions

Established in 1967 by Royal Charter, the University of Stirling was Scotland's first new university in four centuries, built upon the historic Airthrey Estate. It is globally recognised as Scotland's University for Sporting Excellence and houses elite national training facilities. Beyond sport, it excels in Aquaculture, Environmental Science, and Dementia Care, and is home to a highly ranked Business School. Known for its interdisciplinary approach and stunning 330-acre campus featuring Airthrey Castle, Stirling combines a radical founding heritage with a focus on global sustainability and health, consistently ranking among the UK's top institutions for research impact and student experience.
