

## 03 Campus Experience: University of Lausanne

The University of Lausanne, a key institution in the Swiss landscape of higher education and research, is home to around 14,900 students and 3350 full-time staff. Its research activities focus on medicine, life sciences, geosciences, environment, business, humanities and social sciences. Lausanne is located in the heart of French-speaking Switzerland, on the banks of lake Geneva. The closeness to the lake and mountains provides a delightful setting for study and research.

After a short introduction about UNIL, participants will be invited to join a networking lunch together with UNIL colleagues involved in student mobility and faculty representatives. In the afternoon, students will lead each group through the campus to a workshop where they will be able to experience one of the activities conducted at UNIL, such as testing the efficiency of bacteriophages as an alternative to antibiotics, extracting DNA or discovering cardiac coherence at the Sports Centre. The Campus Experience will end with a farewell coffee and opportunity to network.
