

## 03 Campus experience: Hanken School of Economics



The Hanken School of Economics, Finland's only stand-alone university-level business school is delighted to welcome participants to this Campus experience. During the tour, you will be introduced to how a triple-accredited business school in the Nordics operates in an environment characterised by challenges and constant change. You will be given an overview of the wide range of international opportunities offered to domestic and international students and faculty members. Participants will have ample time to speak with university representatives during the networking breaks about their experiences of higher education, internationalisation and cooperation.

Hanken is located in the centre of Helsinki, a 10 minute-walk from the main railway station. The street address is Arkadiankatu 22 (at the corner of the streets 'Runeberginkatu' and 'Arkadiankatu'). A bus transfer is offered in the morning from the conference venue Messukeskus to Hanken. No return bus transfer is required at the end of the tour, and participants are free to make their own way on to their evening activities.
