Experience our labs at RDM Campus

As it is an experience we want you to experience the Campus for yourself by attending workshops in our Aqualab, Automotive lab and the lab of Chemical Engineering.

Boat trip and lunch

We will then take a 15 minute boat trip to the Rotterdam Mainport Institute for a warm lunch. You will be able to see views from the water of the Rotterdam harbours going towards the city centre.

Walk along famous landmarks

We all know these programmes are quite intense. So from the Rotterdam Mainport Institute we will clear our head and take in some fresh air. We will walk alongside our famous landmarks the 'Euromast' and the 'Parksluizen' to arrive at the School of Built Environment and the School of Engineering and Applied Sciences.
